Dear Mr. Oppermann:

This letter is to confirm that your system has been approved for a VSS Waiver for the Stage 2 DBPR Initial Distribution System Evaluation (IDSE) requirement. Your system has satisfied IDSE requirements under the Stage 2 DBPR. However, your system should continue to monitor for total trihalomethanes (TTHM) and the five haloacetic acids (HAA5) in accordance with section 7.6 of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Regulations, if applicable.

Please note that all consecutive and non-consecutive community water systems and nontransient noncommunity water systems that use or deliver water that has been treated with a primary or residual disinfectant other than ultraviolet light will be required to conduct Stage 2 DBPR compliance monitoring for TTHM's and HAA5's. Your next step will be to prepare a monitoring plan for Stage 2 DBPR compliance monitoring. This plan must be completed before you are required to begin Stage 2 DBPR monitoring. Your system must begin Stage 2 DBPR compliance monitoring in October 2013 if your system is not monitoring for Cryptosporidium under the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule, and in October 2014 if your system is monitoring for Cryptosporidium under the Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule.
