Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule ("LT2ESWTR") Monitoring Schedule Reminder

The Water Quality Control Division (the "Division") would like to remind the Public Water System (the "System") that E. coli source water monitoring began October 2008. The only exception to this is if the water system operates seasonally. On the back of this letter you will find the System's complete schedule for LT2ESWTR source water monitoring, with the freedom to sample two days before or two days after the scheduled date.

The Division would also like to provide the System with the following reminders:

- The Sampling Point ID # for the System is: CRS001
- If the System's certified laboratory is unable to analyze the sample due to analytical requirements not being met (i.e. outside of the temperature range or did not meet the holding time requirements) the System has twenty one (21) days to resample. It is important that this issue be documented with the make-up sample, including the original sample date.
- In the case of extreme conditions (i.e. a substantial snow storm prevents the collection of a scheduled sample) the System should sample as soon as possible. It is important that this issue be documented with the make-up sample, including the original sample date.
- It is the responsibility of the System to ensure that all monitoring results are received by the Division on time. Verify with the certified laboratory who is taking on this responsibility, not all labs submit results to the Division. Monitoring results should be submitted to the Division by the 10th day after the month following the month that the samples were taken (i.e. samples taken in October should be submitted to the Division by December 10th).
