- Always indicate the system's PWS ID, Facility ID, and Sample Point ID when submitting sample results.
- <u>Please do not send duplicate information via email, mail, or fax.</u> If requested, your laboratory may send data directly to the Department.
 Please coordinate with your laboratory.
- Please call (303) 692-3308 (OK to leave message) for Positive Total Coliform, Positive E. coli, Nitrate >= 10.0 mg/L, Nitrite >= 1.0 mg/L, or Chlorine Dioxide >= 0.8 mg/L.

Instructions

- New users: Must be assigned organization permissions before submitting files. Please request permissions from current organization users. If you are the first user for an organization please send an email to kaleb.winisko@state.co.us to request permissions.
- Upload: The Upload Files Section is used to transfer files to your File Cabinet. Select the files you wish to upload, then select the Public Water System (PWS), and Category. <u>Category Descriptions</u> are listed below.
- Submit: In the File Cabinet Table verify the PWS, Category, and then use row checkboxes to select files. Once selected, click the submit selected files button.
- Final Confirmation: Once clicked, you will be transferred to a new page to confirm and verify file(s) selected, and perform security verification.
- Help: Please visit our help page for video turtorials and additional information.

Tips, Tricks, and Tidbits

- Try to keep file names simple. Examples: Monitoring Plan, 2015 CCR, Tier 3 PN, Total Coliform Sites, Request for Decreased Sampling, Facility 001 Dec MOR.
- Submitted files cannot be deleted.
- The file is <u>not</u> required to have a signature.
- Uploaded, but not submitted, files are not viewable by the Department and will be deleted if not submitted within 10 days.
- Please submit MORs as Excel files.
- Excel, PDF, and CSV files are allowed. There are several <u>free pdf writers</u> available.
- CSV files are allowed for sample results only. Please visit or <u>help page</u> for more information.
- A maximum of 15 files per upload and each file must be less than 20 MB.
- The PWS column will auto-populate if the PWS ID is located in file name and there is no Default Organization set in the My Profile page.
- Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, and IE10 allow for multiple file selection.
- JavaScript must be enabled.

Category Descriptions

- Certifications PN or CCR or Seasonal Start-Up: Documentation related to Public Notification, Consumer Confidence Rule, or Seasonal Start-Up: certification of delivery, public notice used, consumer confidence report used, and seasonal start-up certification.
- **Enforcement:** Documentation related to Enforcement.
- Inventory System Updates: Contact updates (operator, administrative contact and owner), population, inactivation forms
- Inventory Rule Updates: Documentation related to drinking water rules: Lead and Copper sample sites or materials evaluation, Total Coliform sample sites, sample site maps, LT2 sampling plans
- Requests and Other Certifications: Construction complete as approved certification form (as-built), lead and copper consumer notification, level 1 assessments, responses to compliance advisories, requests, certifications, evaluations (DBP OEL report, investigations), and other general correspondence.
- Complete Monitoring Plan: A complete monitoring plan (all sections included). Please do not use this category for individual sections.
- Sanitary Survey Inspection: Responses to sanitary survey inspection items. Please use Certifications PN category if submitting public notice
- Results Coliform or E. coli: Total Coliform and E. coli with residual disinfectant.
- Results Nitrate or Nitrite: Nitrate or Nitrite.
- Results DBPs and Precursors (Disinfection Byproducts): TTHM, HAA5, Chlorite, Bromate, Chlorine Dioxide (disinfectant). Dissolved Organic Carbon, Total Organic Carbon, Alkalinity, UV 254, Magnesium, and SUVA
- Results Lead and Copper: Lead, Copper, or Water Quality Parameters (Alkalinity, pH, Temperature, Calcium, Conductivity, Total Dissolved Solids, or Inhibitors).
- Results ChemRadsOther: Chemicals, Radionuclides, and Other: Inorganics (IOC) Including Fluoride, Synthetic Organics (SOC), Volatile Organics (VOC), Radionuclides (Rads), surface water microscopic particulate analysis (MPAs), and Acrylamide/Epichlorohydrin certification
- Results MORs: Monthly operating reports (MORs), turbidity, and Entry Point disinfectant results.
- Results SWTR LT2: Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule for Cryptosporidium, E. coli, and turbidity results (only for surface water or GWUDI sources).
